FAMILY GUARDIAN PROGRAMME EVALUATION WITH CHILDREN OCTOBER 2016

This questionnaire was done on line using smartphones or a tablet and was answered by the guardians of the children from the programme and they answered the full set of questions for each child in their formal care. The social educators of the Families took the questionnaire to be answered in their homes and were present to explain the reason for doing the survey and also to clear up any doubts about questions and also to type in the answers of the guardians who are illiterate. The survey was done during the month of October 2016. The team of social educators had no access to the data base produced with the results of the surveys and the raw data is available for audit purposes.
